 - d) The walk gate at the end of the footpath from the car park to the village has a temporary fix. ERYC stated that footpath gate maintenance is the responsibility of the landowner
 - 9. Speed Monitoring ERYC have been consulted regarding the project and agreed to erect a suitable pole. Penny will submit a grant application to the Humberside Police Commission. The pole position and direction of camera to be discussed further.
